

Who is Regenerative Agriculture Network Tasmania?

Regenerative Agriculture Network Tasmania is a not-forprofit incorporated community organisation dedicated to cultivating a farming environment that is drought resilient, diverse, profitable and enjoyable for farmers.

Our mission is to produce food and fibre while prioritising:

- Landscape function
- Soil health
- Biodiversity
- Regenerating perennial grasslands, cropping land and forests
- Sequestering carbon in the soil
- Increasing food and water security
- Farm profitability
- Farmer and community wellbeing

We offer a range of research education initiatives, conferences, mentoring and consultancy, and practical demonstrations designed to foster vibrant community engagement, outcome change on the ground and collaboration among farmers, researchers, and industry stakeholders.

Regenerative Agriculture Network Tasmania has a track record of conducting trials to test and identify how to rapidly regenerate landscapes. Through both independent projects and partnerships with institutions such as the Tasmania Institute of Agriculture, the University of Tasmania and numerous farmer hosts around the state, a substantial body of data has been collected and analysed.

Our Board members have diverse experience in regenerative agriculture, spanning regions such as Mongolia, Brazil, sub-Saharan Africa, the UK, Germany, the United States, and Australia. Additionally, our President has recently completed a Churchill Fellowship focusing on strategies to enhance the widespread and successful delivery of regenerative agriculture outcomes.



What is Regenerative Agriculture?

Regenerative agriculture is a farm management approach that measurably builds drought resilience, landscape function, biodiversity, farm profitability and farmer wellbeing.

When the functionality of the landscape is restored:

- Nutrient and water cycling increases.
- Soil stability improves.
- Carbon is sequestered in the soil, addressing the legacy load of carbon in the atmosphere.
- Biodiversity flourishes.
- Farm businesses are profitable and stable.
- Farms operations are low risk, both financially and environmentally.
- Farming is more sustainable for farmers and their communities.

Research indicates that family and corporate businesses using Regenerative Agriculture principles achieve comparable profit levels to traditional businesses, but with reduced risk. Furthermore, family members report enhanced levels of physical and mental well-being, while the land exhibits clear indicators of improved health, including increased ground cover.
